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A different take on the single-family home: in Johannesburg, South Africa, is a single-family home that looks like a small city at first glance. This is because two larger and a few small pavilions are grouped around a lawn. However, a closer look reveals that this is a residential building for one family.

The buyer of the sharply sloped property wanted to create a single-family home with a family room, living room, kitchen, children's rooms, bedroom, swimming pool, separate office and a separate guest suite. The architect thus developed a building divided into multiple pavilions that features the outlines of an urban ensemble. For the roof and facade, 347 m² of RHEINZINK titanium zinc with the RHEINZINK-prePATINA surface quality in blue grey were installed. The double standing seam system was applied for the roof and the angled standing seam system for the facade.
